

## My Family/ Ma famille Oral Language Games

Adapt the games to be appropriate for the confidence level of the class.  
Use **Picture Cards** from [Plans and Resources](#).

### Show me / Montrez moi

Language structures practised:

- *Montrez moi le père*
- *Voici le père*

#### How to play:

Call out '*Montrez moi le père*'. All children have to point to the correct answer on the sheet **Picture Cards** and respond '*Voici le père*'. Do this in pairs with one child being the teacher and one the child.

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### Find a granny / Trouvez une grand-mère

- Naming nouns eg *Le grand-père* etc

#### How to play:

Cut up three or four sets of picture cards. Give every child a card. Children circulate saying the name of their character to each other until they find all the other grandfathers etc.

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### Find a family / Cherchez - trouvez une famille

- Naming nouns
- *Voici mon père, Voici mon ami* etc

#### How to play:

Use the same cards as in the game above. Teacher calls out 'Make a family of four.' / '*Faisez une famille de quatre.*' Children circulate saying the person on their card trying to make a family with at least one parent, one child and one grandparent. The teacher checks the families; extra children can be friends to a family. The teacher calls out 'Meet another family' / '*Trouvez une autre famille.*' Families join with another. The child introduces everyone by saying '*Voici mon père.*' etc. Play again with five in a family.

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### Kim's Game / Le Jeu de Kim

- *Montrez moi le grand-père*
- *Voici le grand-père*

#### How to play:

Cut up the picture cards. Children have a set of cards between two. Lay out the cards face up and study them. Turn cards over. Child A says '*Montres moi le grand-père.*' Child B has to guess where it is. If they are right they keep the card; if wrong they turn it over. Swap roles and continue until the cards are finished. The winner has the most cards.
