Build Progress

Works are now well underway at the new Sidley Hub. The carpark has been installed, providing a clean hardstanding for the contractors and preventing any significant debris soiling the roads. This also provides an area to park some of their vehicles, reducing impact to local residents and road users.

The foundations, steel frame, concrete beam and block ground floor, as well as the composite concrete first floor have all been installed.

The timber frame 1st floor has also been constructed, along with the ground floor masonry.

Over the past weeks roof coverings, windows and external cladding have all been completed, creating a weather tight building.

At this stage of the build, the main emphasis of the works will now move inside to commence the installation of the services.

As we build, we're excited to bring Heart of Sidley's vision to life with a permanent Graffiti Wall, ensuring the community's creative spirit has a lasting home at Sidley Hub!


